impacts entire
ecosystem

- substantial **burden** on NRAs
- confusion, complexity, **high** costs, **slow** adoption, potential **exclusion** in int'l industry
- negative outcomes for **genuine** international communications
- **limited efficiency** achieving “anti nuisance” objectives

lessons
learned:
need a
joint, united
response

uncoordinated response, driven by NRAs only,
has **limitations**

int'l carriers are part of the solution, need to be
part of the **discussion**

stakeholders **need** each other

we all share the **same** objective

our vision: address NRAs concerns, co-develop solutions, policies, governance

1 unified guidance

- standardized global guidance
- efficient & industry viable solutions
- drive industry adoption

2 self/joint regulation

- self/joint regulation framework to enforce unified guidance, solutions
- opt-in framework for carriers, NRAs
- compliance monitoring and enforcement
- compliance brings “Trusted Carrier” benefits from industry/NRAs
- non-compliance brings penalties from industry/NRAs

3 joint governance

- joint industry/NRA management of self/joint regulation framework
- grow NRA participation
- jointly address new issues, adapt & improve framework

- inclusive, neutral, agile, pragmatic
- not for profit
- no membership fees, activities funded by members
- governed by traffic carrying players

- build/strengthen global **multilateral** collaboration,
- discuss concerns, expectation, priorities, path forward
- **engagement model(s)** with other stakeholders

opportunity for **National Communications Associations**

- build/strengthen **inter-national** cooperation,
- identify shared concerns, joint proposals
- **engagement model(s)** with other stakeholders

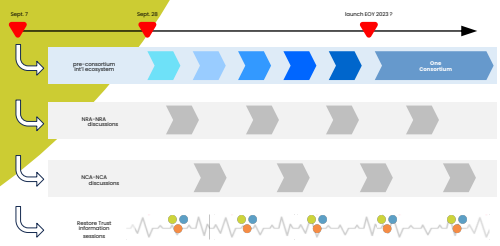

i3forum offers to **organize & facilitate** initial meetings

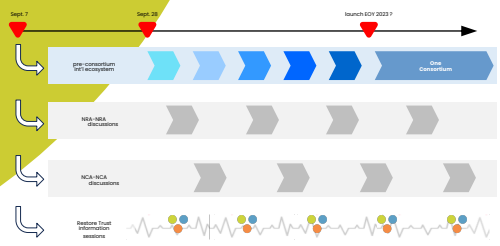
proposed **initial pace**: meet every other week

only **one** voting participant for each organization

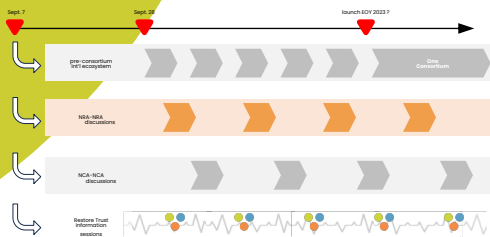
limited number of participants to ensure efficiency

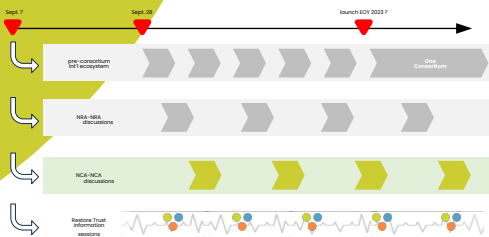
National Regulatory Authorities

proposed way forward

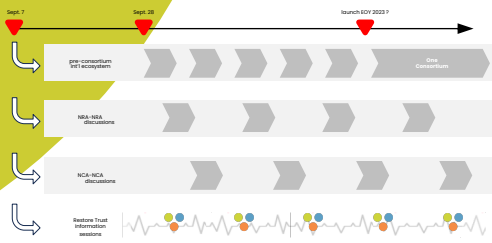
- build on existing multi-lateral discussions
