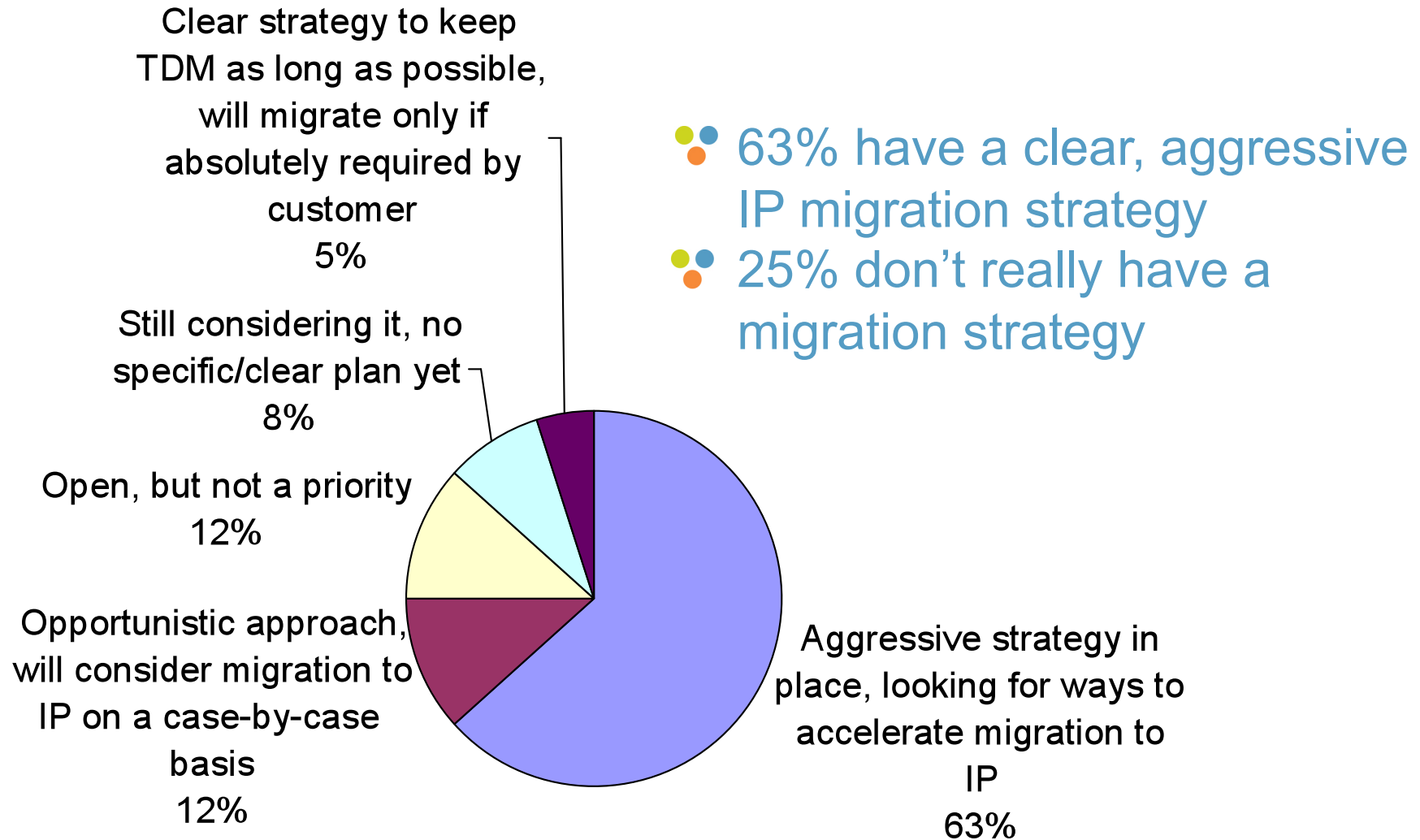

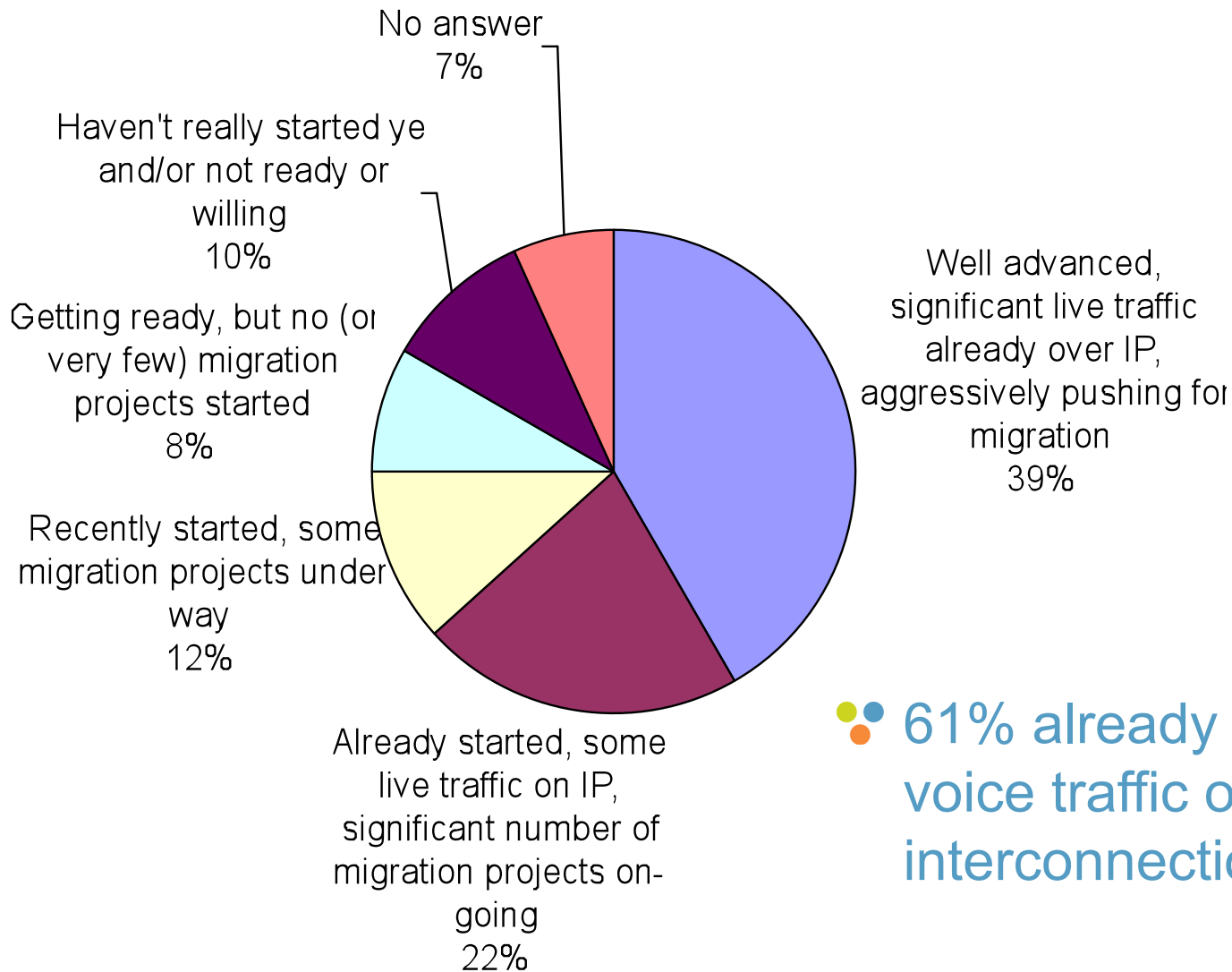


# Testing the waters... Strategy

# Testing the waters... Readiness

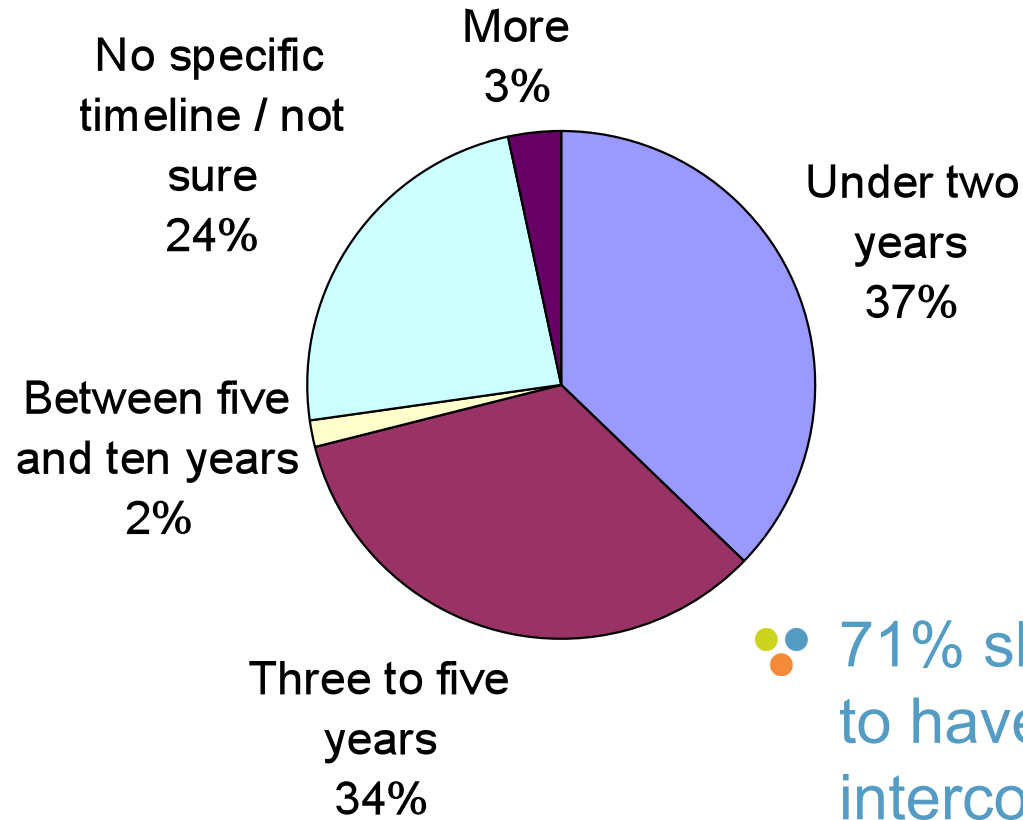


61% already have live voice traffic on migrated IP interconnections

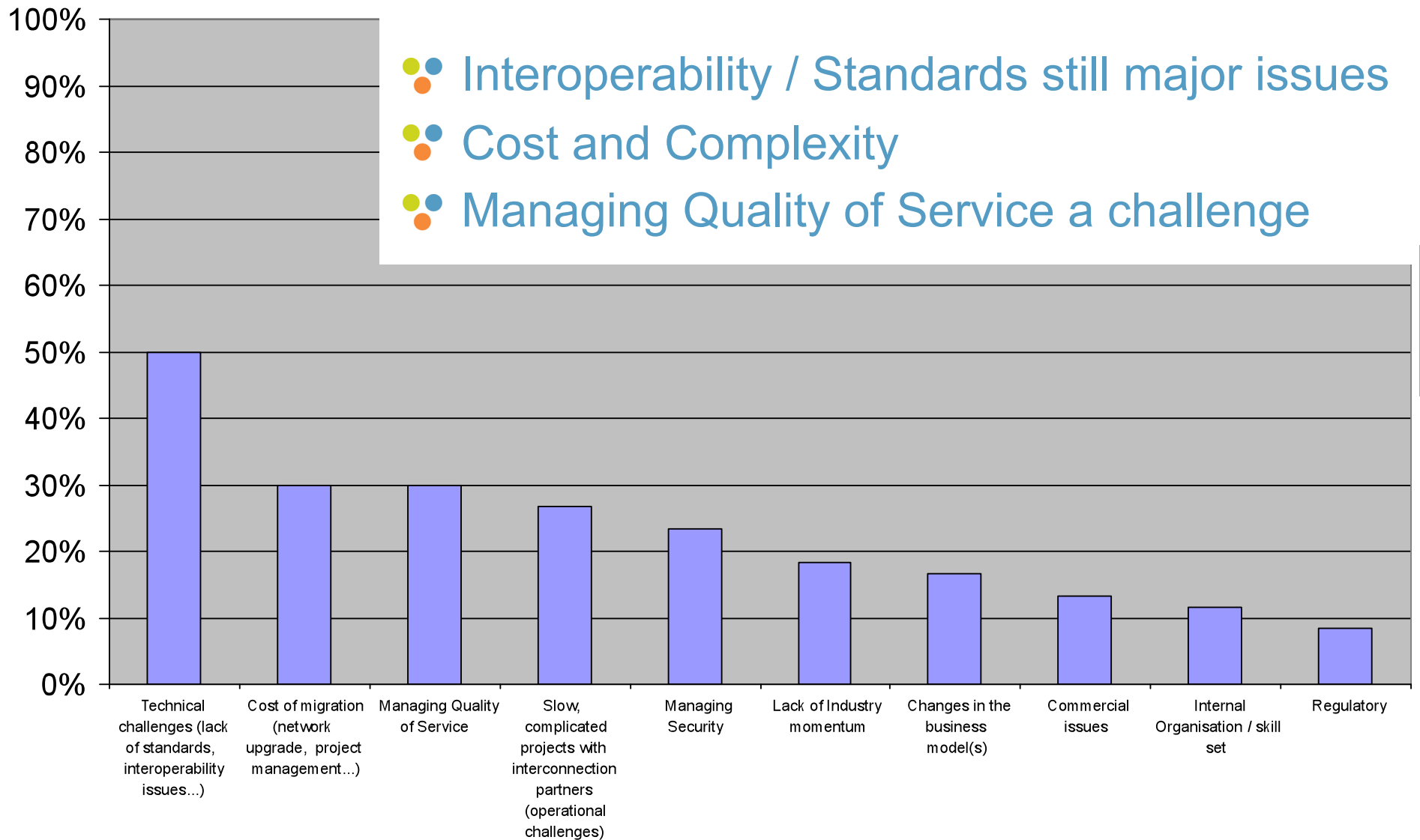

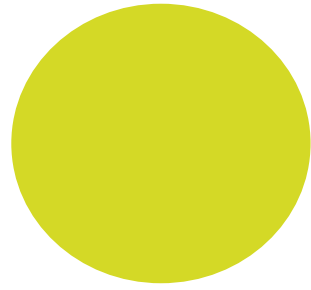

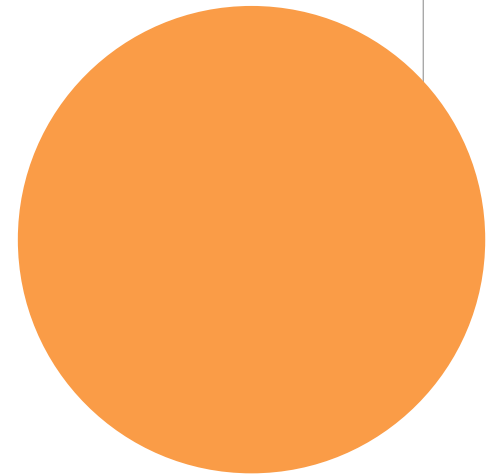
