

Multiple reasons to transition to IP - and it is happening NOW!




Technology

- ❖ Green




Business

Why migrate to IP? Food for thought

TDM	VoIP
Switch port efficiency for average International carrier	Static port assignment resulting in 230k minutes/E1 or 3 x lower switch costs
Better voice quality using less backbone resources	G711 TDM codec uses 64k for phone sound quality
Ring Back Tones forgotten cost	Eat up 15% of backbone resources
Launch new services	Problematic due to 64k based framework



Together we need to shape that Future !!

- ❖ Industry has to get to the “other side” fast to reap benefits of all-IP world
- ❖ When and how to move from a world that works to an IP New World?
 - ❖ Not always “plug and play”
 - ❖ Not automatic continuation of existing interconnection business models
 - ❖ Unintended consequences of earlier standards decisions
- ❖ Many questions, few answers....
 - ❖ What technology decisions should I make?
 - ❖ What should I invest in and when? Will it work with other carriers?
 - ❖ What happens to my existing business? Where are the new opportunities?
 - ❖ What about Quality? And Security?
 - ❖ Do I need to re-invent the wheel with all my partners?
- ❖ That's where we step in - Carriers Interconnects are key to end-to-end service
 - ❖ i3forum develops recommendations (business, technology, operations) for an industry-wide transition of voice and other services to IP
